- **Don't limit your future by not trying on the SAT!**
- SAT Information
  - Scoring from 400-1600 (About 10 Points per Question with a National Average of 1000)
    - Starts at 200 and goes up for correct answers, but you do not go down if it is wrong
    - 800 points available in reading
    - 800 points available in math
    - Don't leave questions blank - guess the same letter
  - Subjects Tested (even if it seems like it is asking something else):
    - Math
      - Algebra
      - Advanced Math
      - Data Analysis/Problem Solving
    - Reading
    - Language

    - Question of the day
    - Pop Quiz of the day - 6 questions that are graded on the spot
      - 2 reading
      - 2 writing
